

City of Salisbury -

Salisbury Youth Aerosol Art Project (\$17,038.00)

This project aims to engage young people within the City of Salisbury who have been identified as at risk or displaying risk factors in a program with mentoring by an artist and social skill development, to improve relationships with Police and Local Government, and promote ownership through aerosol art in public areas that have been targeted by graffiti.

Your Choices Program (\$14,853.60)

"Your Choices" is a program developed together with SA Police as a program to refer young offenders to as part of a Family Conference outcome. The Family Conference is a diversion from the Youth Court that affords a young offender (10-17 years of age) an opportunity to make restitution to the victim or community.

The Youth Affairs Council of South Australia - Young People in Public Spaces Project (\$43,520.00)

This project will develop and deliver a train-the-trainer package to equip key youth workers, youth services networks and organisations working with young people around South Australia, to train relevant people in their communities to effectively manage young people in public spaces, with particular focus on vulnerable young people and those from diverse backgrounds.

Legal Services Commission - Legal Education and Awareness Project (LEAP) (\$47,883.00)

LEAP aims to reduce the risk of African youth from refugee and migrant backgrounds engaging in antisocial behaviour and criminal activity. The program will deliver a legal education program to young people and their service providers. A resource kit, for use by educators, service providers and policy makers will also be provided.

City of Tea Tree Gully - Project Y (\$50,000.00)

Project Y will build the capacity of young women engaging in or at risk of engaging in crime and anti-social behaviour. Through a strengths based approach, young women will engage in a self affirmation program of arts and life-skills. Project Y will empower young women and provide meaningful links to the community.

Town of Gawler - North on Target Project (\$40,000.00)

An early intervention and peer education program with parental and community involvement targeting 11-12 year olds at schools within the Local Government regions of Gawler, Tea Tree Gully, Salisbury, and Playford. North of Target is aimed at reducing the early uptake of substance use by young people and preventing substance related crime.

City of Marion - Piecing it Together Project (\$20,900.00)

This project aims to reduce graffiti and anti-social behaviours by engaging with young graffiti offenders and at risk youth to develop mutual respect, social connection and positive mental health through a program of aerosol art workshops and legal murals, delivered in partnership with local youth and health services.

City of Mt Gambier, Youth Advisory Committee - SAVE-A-MATE Project (\$10,180.00)

The City of Mt Gambier Youth Advisory Committee in conjunction with the City of Mt Gambier Council will implement the Red Cross SAVE-A-MATE program, a peer driven education program to educate and minimise harm surrounding the use of drugs and alcohol by young people in the Limestone Coast community.

Baptist Community Services (S.A.) Inc - Tau Pathun Project (\$49,063.00)

Tau Pathun targets at risk Indigenous and non-Indigenous youth aged 13-24 through community partnership and networks. The project combines wilderness adventure camps, practical work programs, mentoring and cultural learning initiatives to engage young people, build resilience and prevent youth crime in the inner city and northern Adelaide.

Adelaide City Council - Safety Initiatives in Adelaide's East End Entertainment Precinct Project (\$50,000.00)

The Safety Initiatives in Adelaide's East End Entertainment Precinct project will address crime and anti-social behaviour fuelled by alcohol and other drug use. The project will develop policy directions and engage relevant agencies and community members in the implementation of strategies around late night land use, alcohol management and safer dispersal.

Vietnamese Community in Australia (SA Chapter Inc.) - Truancy and Substance Abuse Prevention Project for Vietnamese Youths Project (\$50,000.00)

The project will provide youth programs to Vietnamese students; link at risk students to direct services; develop a Vietnamese youth mentor system; organise community and parenting educational programs for Vietnamese parents about youth's issues; and develop a safe place for youth to hang out after school hours.

Marra Murrangga Kumangka Inc - Dare 2 Dream "Nunga Drumming Group" Project (\$33,235.00)

Dare 2 Dream is a behaviour management project for Indigenous students identified to have behavioural, attendance, literacy and numeracy issues. The program will focus on building social and interpretative skills. It will also identify and address concerns about literacy, numeracy and communication through program activities.

Offenders Aid and Rehabilitation Services of SA Inc - Women's Mentoring Program (WMP)
(\$50,000.00)

This program is designed to prepare volunteers to establish and maintain effective mentoring relationships with women preparing for and released from prison. It is directed towards promoting skills development, behaviour change, release preparation and community integration. This program will provide beneficial outcomes for women exiting prison, personal and professional development of the volunteers and the wider community.

The Rural City of Murray Bridge - Creative Community Connections Project (\$43,860.00)

Creative Community Connections will address crime prevention and community safety through engaging young offenders and those at risk of offending in creative public arts projects. This engagement is underpinned by a network of partnerships, support and mentoring that strengthens connections with the wider community through engagement and empowerment.
